- 5) The percentage of Adult program participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the **fourth quarter** after exit from the program (for title I Youth, the indicator is participants in education, or training activities or employment in the 4th quarter after exit);
- 6) Same for Dislocated Workers;
- 7) Similar for Youth as referenced in 5);
- 8) Same for Wagner-Peyser;
- 9) The median earnings of Adult program participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the second quarter after exit from the programs;
- 10) Same for Dislocated Workers;
- 11) Same for Wagner-Peyser; (not for Youth).
- 12) The percentage of Adult program participants who attain a recognized postsecondary credential, or a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent, during participation in or within 1 year after exit from the program;
- 13) Same for Dislocated Workers;
- 14) Same for Youth;

Not being negotiated at this time:

- 15) The percentage of Adult program participants who, during a program year, are in an education or training program that leads to a recognized postsecondary credential or employment and who are achieving measurable skill gains toward such a credential or employment;
